To enrich the programme, we have partnered with a variety of external providers. This enables us to offer a broader selection of clubs, giving children the opportunity to explore diverse interests—under the guidance and supervision of their parents.

Please refer to the table below for the complete list of free and paid club options available this term.

## Important Club Selection Notes:

Prep and Primary pupils may join up to 10 clubs, provided the clubs are still available and age-appropriate. If they are invited to a By Invitation club, it must be prioritised above others. Middle and Senior pupils may join a maximum of 5 clubs, most of which fall under the By Invitation categories. Pupils receiving invitations are expected to prioritise these clubs and commit to attendance.

## “By Invitation” Clubs?

“By Invitation” Clubs are specially curated activities open only to selected pupils, based on skill, consistency, leadership, or teacher recommendation. These include higher-level training, academic teams, school representatives, and competitive squads. Participation is not available through open sign-up and is strictly by teacher nomination or audition.

Examples may include the seasonal Debate Team, Student Council, Junior Math, EAL, Cambridge Checkpoints, AS/A Level, Young Science Club, Young Mandarin/Hindi, Matriculation Preparation, or certain sports competitions among the Free Clubs. This will be informed to parents in advance.

We thank you for your patience as we piloted this expanded daily club programme to offer pupils a broader variety of enriching experiences.

## Club Registration Process – Two Rounds via EduPage:

Round 1: Opens today at 12 Noon

Each pupil may register for two clubs only. This ensures fair access for all pupils. Should more than two clubs be selected, the system will automatically remove selections at random. This round is to be completed by parents only as part of the Consent process.

Round 2: Before 6 August 2025

This round will be redistributed (if needed) to:

Pupils whose clubs were cancelled due to insufficient numbers

Remaining available club slots (no limit on selection)

This round will also be first come, first served.

## Paid Clubs: Confirmation & Payment Procedure

For Paid Clubs, registration is only confirmed once proof of payment has been submitted to:

### Junior and Young English Club – Mr Strydom

This club is designed to give pupils regular, natural exposure to spoken English through direct interaction led by Mr Strydom, an international educator who has recently arrived in Indonesia, bringing with him a fresh linguistic environment that enhances immersion. Sessions will include conversation practice, storytelling, games, and pronunciation workshops in a relaxed, supportive setting. The club is ideal for both primary and senior pupils who wish to strengthen their English communication through immersion and guided interaction with native speakers.

### Junior and Young Golf Club



This club offers pupils the opportunity to learn and enjoy the fundamentals of golf in a structured and engaging environment. Sessions are held at the Golf and Padel Ground under the guidance of professional instructors. Pupils starting Grade 3 will develop essential skills, including grip, posture, swing techniques, and golf etiquette. All equipment, including clubs and balls, will be provided on-site. This club is suitable for both beginners and those wishing to refine their technique. Children will be taken by our school driver using the school van and picked up by parents at Candhi Golf.

### Young Padel Club - Mesa Padel

Experience one of the fastest-growing sports in the world! Padel combines the best of tennis and squash. Held at the newly built Mesa Padel, this fun and engaging club builds fitness, coordination, and teamwork. Children will be accompanied by the school staff. All necessary equipment, including rackets.

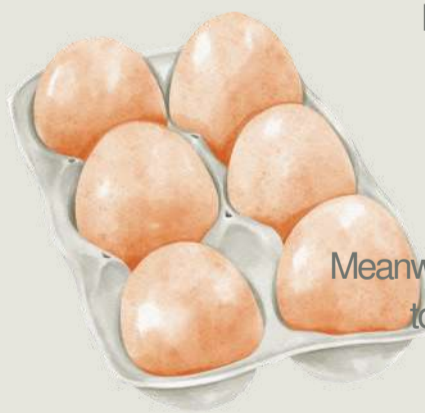

### Junior and Young Cooking Club – Boboy Kitchen

Little chefs love this hands-on culinary adventure! Pupils learn cooking techniques, kitchen safety, and teamwork guidance will be personally led by Ms Augustine, the owner of Boboy Kitchen and accompanied by one of our teachers.

### Junior and Young Robotics Club – Timedoor Academy

Future engineers begin here, provided to you by the Timedoor Academy. Pupils build and program real robots, enhancing coding and problem-solving skills. Young club will do coding on the Computer in the GMIS Semarang Computer Lab. parents.

### Junior Green Thumb Club

Green Thumb Club offers pupils the opportunity to develop hands-on gardening skills while learning about the environment and sustainability in an interactive and nurturing setting. We invite parents who have access to 3R (reduce, reuse, recycle) to reach to school to support us with this Club and grow the club into bigger program with society impact



### Junior Ballet Club

Pupils in Ballet Club will explore the grace and discipline of classical ballet. Sessions focus on posture, coordination, rhythm, and expressive movement, fostering both physical strength and artistic confidence. The programme is led by experienced instructors and designed to suit the developmental stage of each age group. Ballet attire is recommended for ease of movement and performance readiness can be ordered for IDR 500,000



### Taekwondo Club

Taekwondo Club offers pupils the opportunity to develop physical fitness, focus, and self-discipline through the practice of this traditional Korean martial art. Sessions cover basic forms (poomsae), self-defence techniques, and respect-based training. Pupils progress in belt level as they demonstrate mastery and commitment. Uniforms and protective gear may be required depending on level and intensity.

### French Club

In French Club, pupils are introduced to the French language and culture through engaging activities, basic conversation practice, songs, and games. Designed for beginners, this club fosters early language acquisition and global awareness in a fun and supportive environment. Pupils will gradually build vocabulary, listening, and speaking skills under the guidance of a language facilitator from the Alliance Francaise.

Through this programme, children will have the opportunity to begin their pathway towards obtaining DELF certifications (separate offer) from an early age — one of the internationally recognised qualifications often considered for language-related scholarships.



### Junior Qur'an Reading Club

The Qur'an Reading Club is offered as a respectful and focused space for pupils to strengthen their recitation and understanding of the Qur'an.

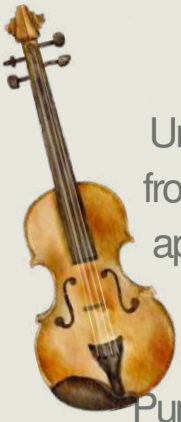
Pupils practise correct pronunciation (tajwid), memorisation, and reflection in a nurturing setting. This club supports pupils in their spiritual and moral development, guided by a qualified instructor, Mr Latief.

### Junior Entrepreneurship – Art, Craft and Painting Club

This club offers pupils a creative space to explore various artistic techniques and express their imagination through hands-on projects. Pupils will work with different materials to create individual and collaborative artworks, enhancing their fine motor skills, creativity, and appreciation for visual aesthetics. Activities may include drawing, painting, paper craft, and seasonal decorations, all designed to support artistic development in a relaxed and enjoyable environment. Materials will be provided.

Selections of products will be sold on selections of dates and events at GMIS Semarang! All proceeds go to charity!



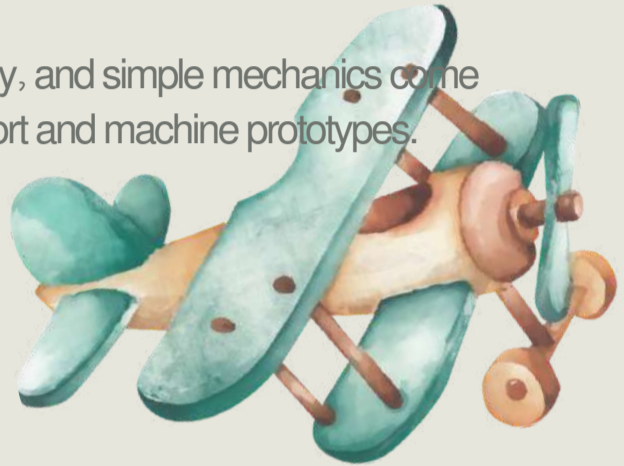


### Violin Club

Unlock musical talent through structured violin training led by professionals from Halmahera Music. Pupils gain discipline, fine motor skills, and musical appreciation while preparing for potential performances. Violin is required.

### Engineering Club

Pupils will design and test various transportation models by applying real-world science and engineering concepts. Using materials such as cardboard boxes, materials - which all will be provided - they will explore how motion, energy, and simple mechanics come together to create functional transport and machine prototypes.

### Junior and Young Extended Tuition Class

These sessions are arranged privately by the teacher outside the official school programme. To provide time for the academic staff to contribute in the Clubs sessions the Tuition class will now be offered afterschool hours starting at 3.10, please note that they are not part of the co-curricular offerings. Participation is entirely optional, and any arrangements—including schedule, fees, and content—are to be made directly between the teacher and the parents. The school does not manage or supervise these sessions.
