Dear parents and guardians,

We would like to address you today with a matter that is causing us increasing concern.

Recently, we have increasingly noticed that some pupils are not adhering to basic rules of conduct and are disregarding their school duties.

The rights and duties of pupils are clearly regulated in Art. 56 BayEUG:

[...] "Pupils must refrain from doing anything that could disrupt school operations or the order of the school they attend or another school." [...]

The following is therefore expected

- respectful behavior towards teachers and school staff
- punctuality at the start of school (7:50 a.m. in the morning, arriving on time even if lessons start later) and after breaks
- the presence of complete work materials
- willingness to participate in lessons
- following the instructions of teachers and school staff
- ban on cell phones
- regular participation in afternoon lessons, especially in the BoZ-subject

Teachers' instructions are intended to enable students to work properly and must always be followed. These are not the basis for discussions between teachers and pupils.

Furthermore, it is already known that the use of cell phones is **strictly prohibited**, except in cases explicitly approved by teachers.

We are no longer prepared to accept these rule violations in the current frequency.

We would therefore like to point out that Art. 86 BayEUG stipulates that educational and disciplinary measures can be taken against pupils to safeguard the educational mission or to protect other persons.

These include:

- Sending home in the event of permanent disruption of lessons
- Pre- and after-work for latecomers
- Social services for the school family
- Compulsory attestation and fines for unexcused absences
- Exclusion from school for several days

We will of course inform you of any measures taken.

As parents and guardians, please ensure that your children conscientiously fulfill their school duties (Art. 76 BayEUG) and support the educational work of the school.

We select all measures in accordance with the prescribed principle of proportionality.

This regulation also applies to the OGT and the afternoon courses of the BWS.
